



WHAT IS PEPPER SPRAY?

Pepper spray allows you to defend yourself at a safe distance outside the arm's reach of an attacker, giving you the chance to escape with time to reach safety. Pepper spray is sometimes commonly referred to as OC spray, since it is made from Oleoresin Capsicum, a natural ingredient derived from hot peppers powerful enough to temporarily impair an attacker when coming in direct contact with their eyes, nose, and mouth. 1 Use strong verbal commands to intimidate the attacker.

Shout:

BACK OFF! STAY BACK!

If you can't escape, face an attacker with your pepper spray.


STOP!

Hold with your fingers around the grip, down at your side, concealed from view. Assertively yell again, "Stop! Stay back!"

If the attacker does not listen, form a pyramid base with your feet, head above hips for balance. Hold your pepper spray upright, free hand forward, palm open.

Spray in short bursts aimed directly at the attacker's face.

Leave the area immediately & get to a safe place!
